

Workshop facilitation guide

approx. 60 mins

Suggested audience: Subject departments in schools and kura

This guide supports schools' and kura subject departments have an in-depth discussion on the proposed NCEA subjects in *The New Zealand Curriculum* (Levels 2 and 3) and/or *Te Marautanga o Aotearoa* (across all Levels), and to provide feedback via the online survey.

Workshop Objectives:

- » To support schools' and kura subject departments and their kaiako to engage in a meaningful conversation on what the proposed subject means for teaching and learning.
- » To capture feedback to share with the Ministry of Education to consider for final recommendations.

Supporting material:

Kaiako are also welcomed to provide individual feedback should they wish.

Ground rules:

There are no right or wrong answers or ideas. The main thing is to support participants to share their feedback on proposed NCEA subjects.

- » **Respect** the different experiences and views that are shared
- » **Encourage** everyone to engage in conversation and listen while others are talking
- » Be **Considerate** of the diversity in your group

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Workshop outline

- » Welcome and Karakia (where appropriate).
- » Clearly identify the Learning Area and/or Wāhanga Ako and proposed subjects the discussion will focus on, and whether your department will engage with either *The New Zealand Curriculum* or *Te Marautanga o Aotearoa*, or both.
- » Using the supporting materials listed above, invite the participants to respond to the below questions and allow time to capture and share feedback.
 - › Do you support the proposed NCEA subjects for *The New Zealand Curriculum* and/or *Te Marautanga o Aotearoa*? Why?
 - › Will the proposed subjects allow schools to offer rich learning programmes for their ākongā?
 - › Will the proposed subjects help ākongā prepare for life beyond school?

- » Departments are welcomed to provide the responses directly into the survey, otherwise, please ensure that conversations are captured so that someone in your department can provide collective feedback via the online survey.
- » Depending on the curriculum and subject(s) the department is providing feedback on, refer to the relevant discussion documents and Learning Area section, and respond to the specific questions that the Ministry would like feedback on.
