Review of Achievement Standards

## Overview & Important Information

### Description

The third Accord Teacher Only Day will take place in schools and kura between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of August 2021 and will focus on the Review of Achievement Standards (RAS) part of the NCEA Change Programme. The primary purpose of this Teacher Only Day is to focus on familiarisation with the latest NCEA Level 1 subject materials.

The day will be supported with resources provided by the Ministry of Education in partnership with the Sub-Accord Group which introduce the new NCEA Level 1 materials and provide a structured approach to discussing how these materials can be implemented within local contexts. A wide range of materials and resources will be provided, empowering schools to customise the Teacher Only Day to meet their own needs and priorities.

Information and updates on content for the day will be communicated directly to school leaders via email.



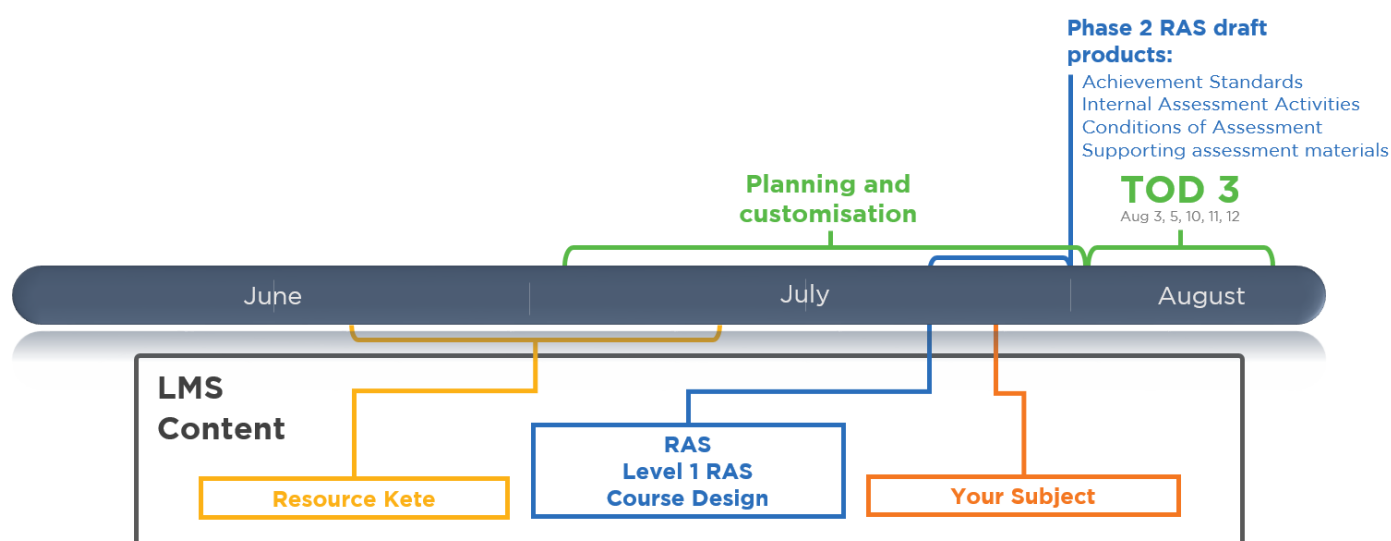
### Resources

The resources provided by the MOE in partnership with the Sub-Accord Group will include videos, weblinks and documents which provide an overview of what changes have been made to each subject and why, including the design process and thinking. These will be made available in a Resource Kete (with a provisional date of July 9<sup>th</sup>, although some materials may be added after this date).

A series of modules hosted on the Learning Management System (LMS) will also be made available to provide structured guidance to approaching the new materials for schools that want it.
