NCEA Change Programme **Strengthening NCEA for our young people**



Around 150,000 students study each year towards NCEA.

What is NCEA?

The National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) is the main school leaving qualification in New Zealand. NCEA has three levels – Level 1-3.

What is the NCEA Change Programme?

The NCEA Change Programme is a work programme led by the Ministry of Education to deliver the package of seven changes aimed at strengthening NCEA. The changes were informed by a year-long public engagement in 2018, and confirmed by the Government in February 2020.

We are working with schools, young people, families/whānau and communities to deliver the NCEA changes. The changes will be phased in over five years, with new achievement standards at Levels 1, 2 and 3 in place by January 2025.
