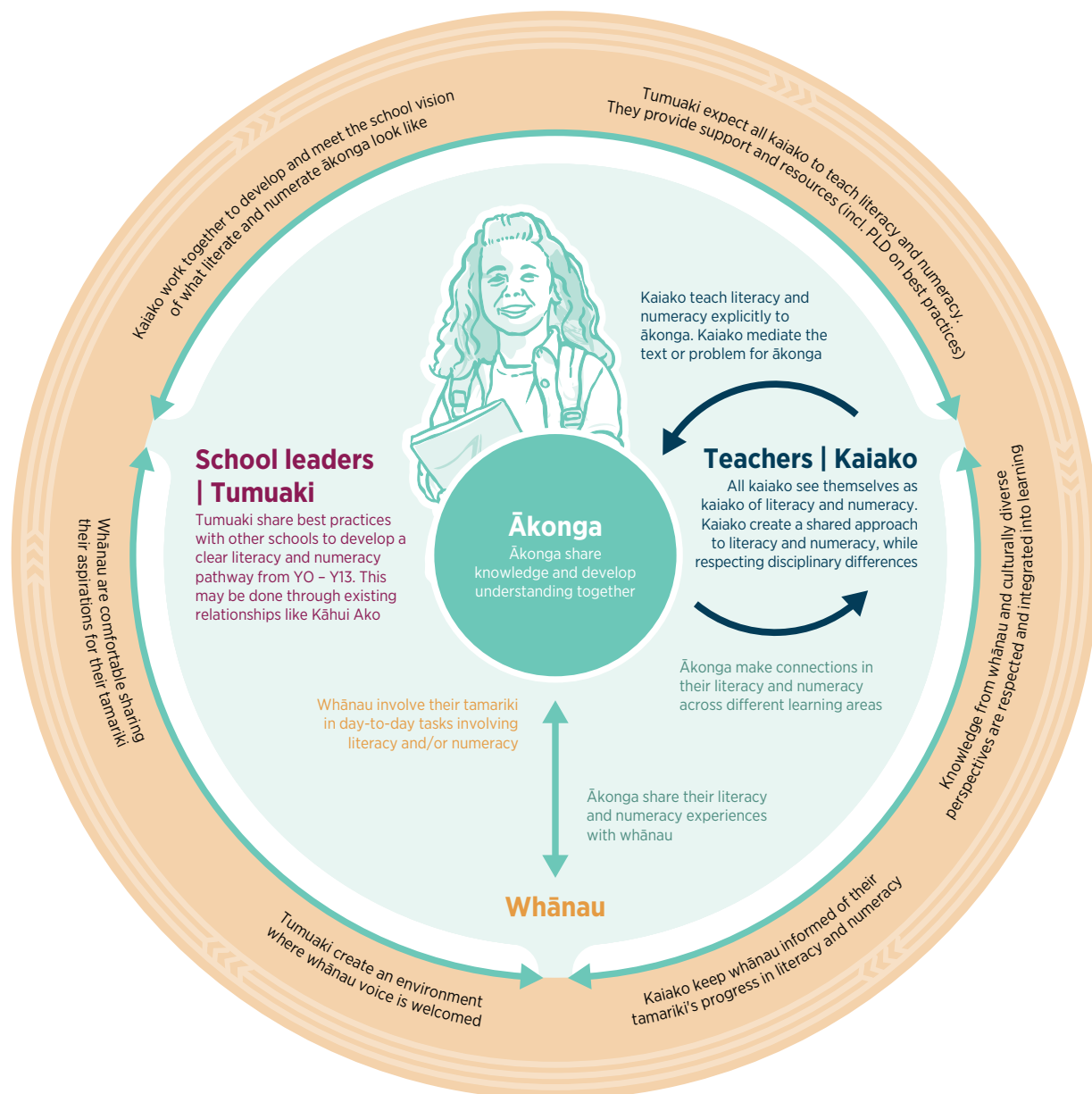


Effective Relationships that Support Literacy and Numeracy Development
