Reflection:

Analysis, evaluation. Identifying strengths and weaknesses. Identifying new areas of direction, underpinning ideas.

Production:

Initial works progressing with subsequent cycles to more resolved outcomes. Rehearsal, Performance.

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Critiques

Group, class or one to one with teacher. Korero. What ideas do we have? What else can be tried? Which are the most successful? Which ideas should we explore further? Next steps.

Processes & Exploring:

Improvising, refining, devising, making, testing, experimenting, trying different materials, styles and techniques, jamming, practising. Unexpected outcomes-serendipity!

Research:

Issues, ideas, knowledge, context surrounding a brief or proposal. Looking for inspiration.

Planning:

Organising materials, gathering, structure, order, photoshoots, props, subject matter, group roles, thumbnails, sketches.
