<p>Minimum requirements <i>1-1.5 minutes of spoken te reo Māori, or 200-250 words of written reo Māori, or and equivalent combination of both (40 seconds of speaking, and 120-150 words of writing).</i></p>		
<p>Language vitality context <i>Reference to events/experience within a Māori cultural context that relates to the health or promotion of reo Māori.</i></p>		
<p>Different speaking and writing evidence <i>If evidence consists of speaking and writing the content of each needs to be different.</i></p>		
<p>Authenticity <i>No use of electronic translators / AI input. No use of a template that scaffolds the task. Language should reflect no teacher input.</i></p>		
<p>Events / experiences <i>A minimum of two present and past events / experiences. Future events are optional.</i></p>		
<p>Curriculum level of language <i>Used up to and including curriculum level 6 language to express ideas, information and opinions.</i></p>		
<p>Consistent language <i>Consistent level of language which can be understood.</i></p>
