
Supporting students after co-requisite results

A resource for teachers and school leaders

The following information is provided for interpreting and responding to student results from the dedicated co-requisite standards in reading, writing, and numeracy.

Who receives results?

- Schools and kura receive an overall report summarising non-achievement across the student cohort.
- **Students who do not achieve** one or more dedicated co-requisite standards receive an individual feedback report. The table below is an example of this report:



- The Student Feedback Report can be downloaded from the schools' secure website under 'General Security Features, Reports'.
- To achieve one or more of the <u>reading</u>, <u>writing</u> or <u>numeracy</u> standards, students must:
 - Provide relevant evidence for each listed outcome
 - o Meet the minimum overall score across the assessment.
